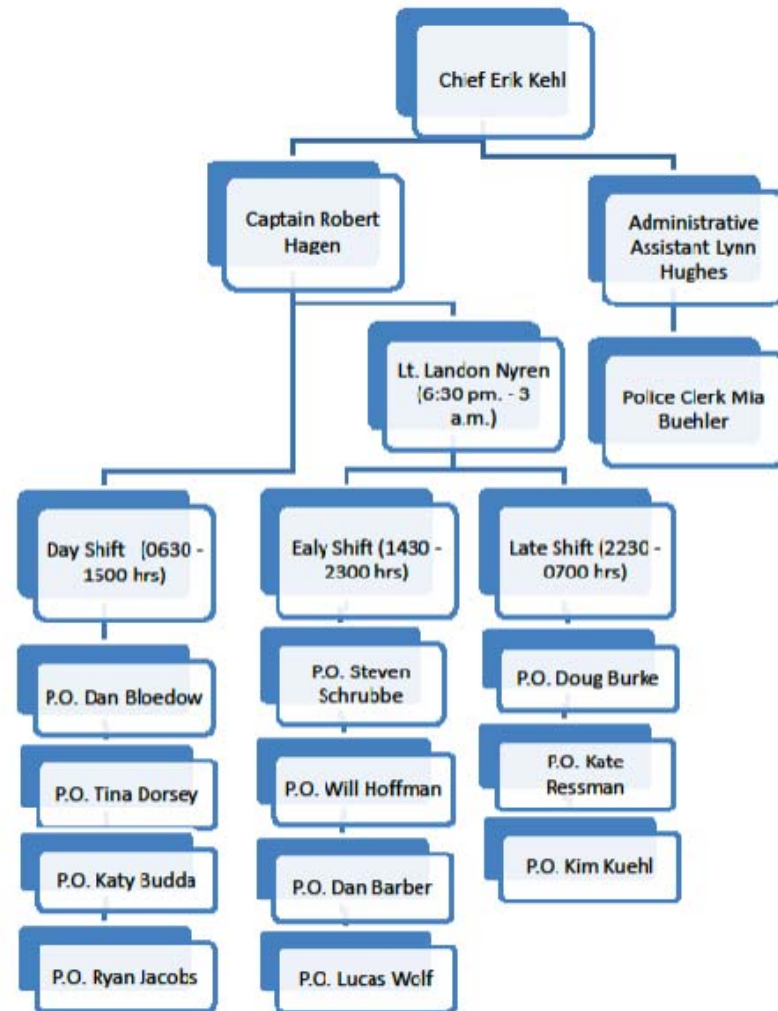

- 16 FTE's

 - 1 Chief
 - 1 Captain
 - 1 Lieutenant
 - 11 Patrol Officers
- 2 FTE Police Clerks
- 24/7/365 service
- Minimum Staffing:
 - 1 Officer per shift
 - Ideal =/> 2 members / shift
 - Includes Chief, Capt. And Lt.

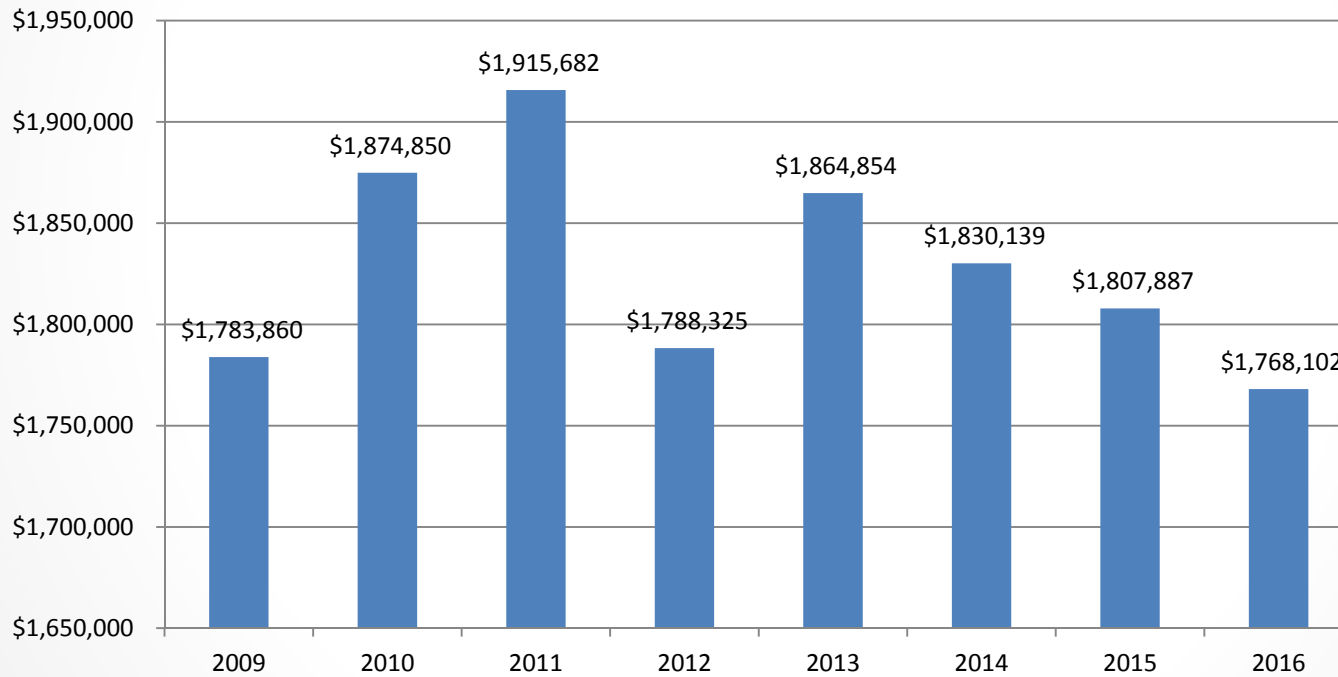
City of Delafield Police Department Organizational Chart

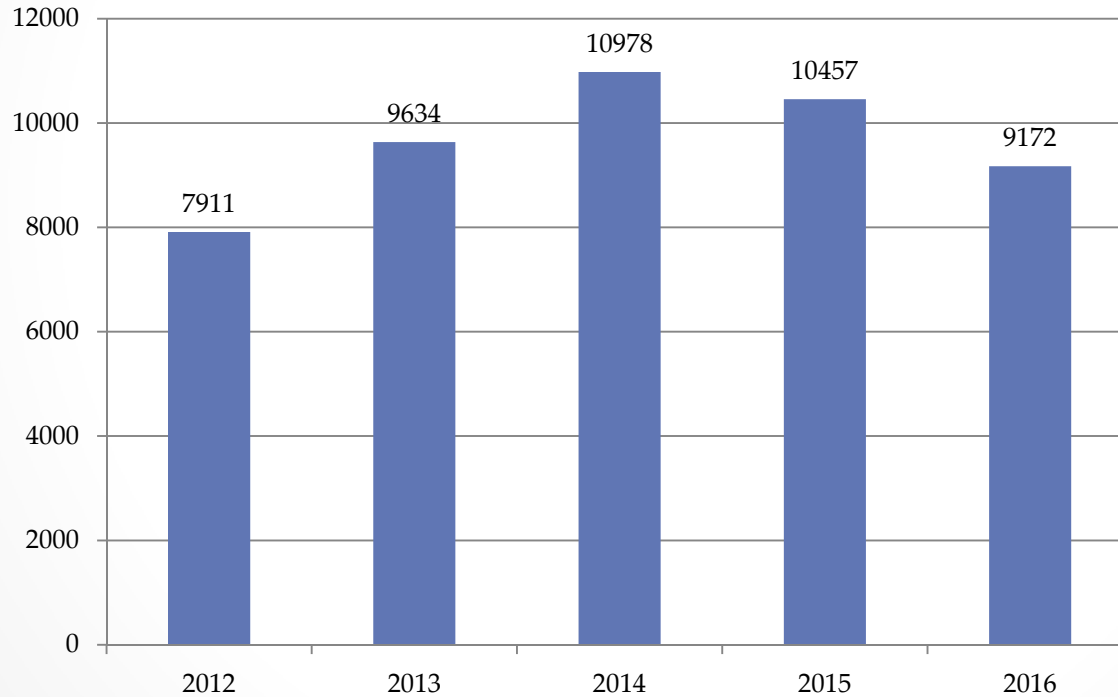

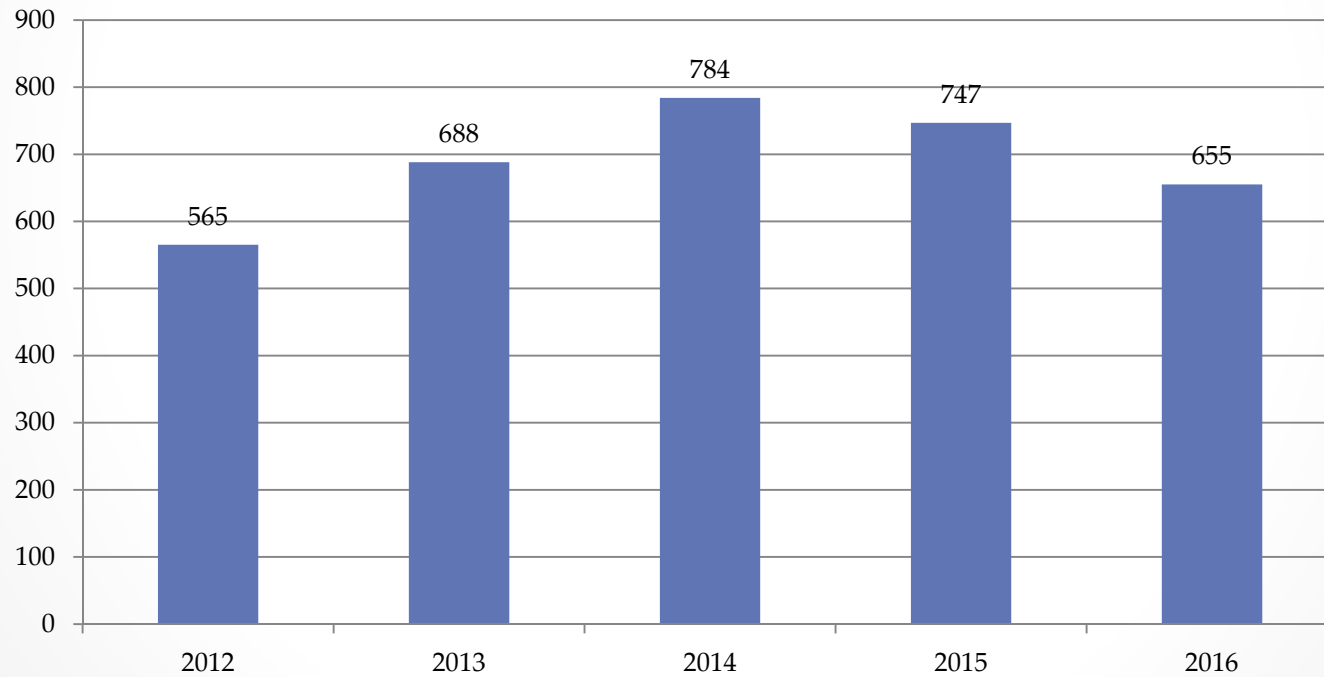

 - Total Calls for Service as of end of day on 09/30/2016



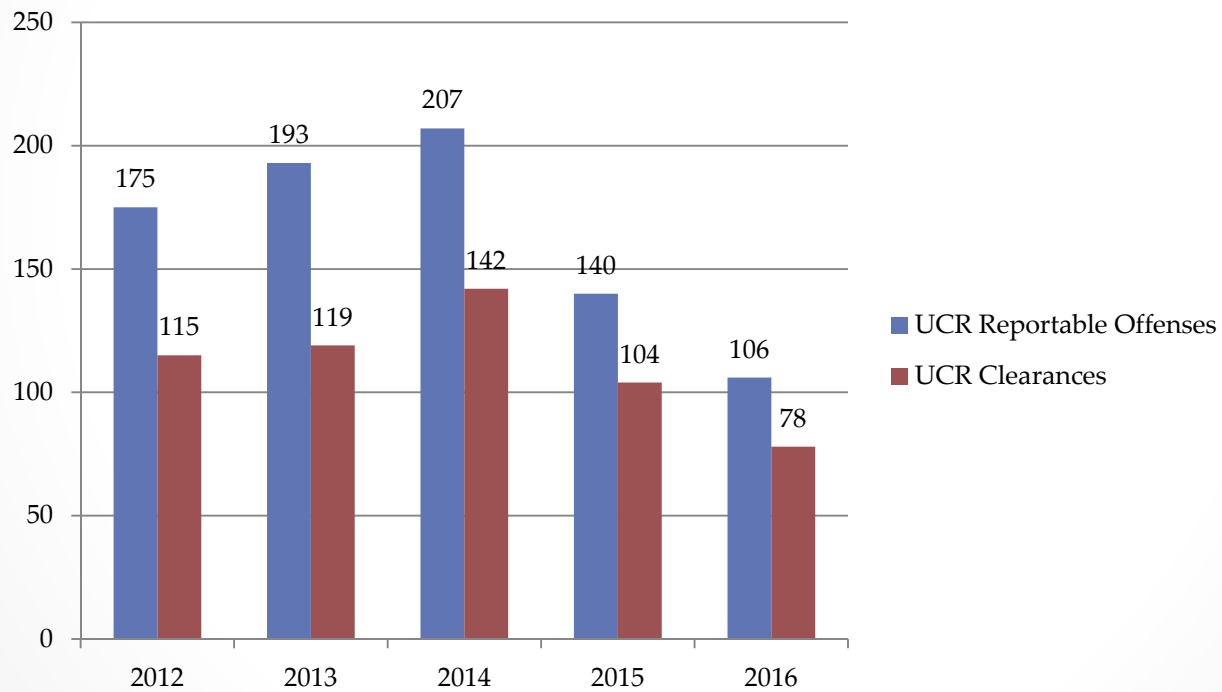

 - Total Calls for Service per Officer at of end of day on 09/30/2016



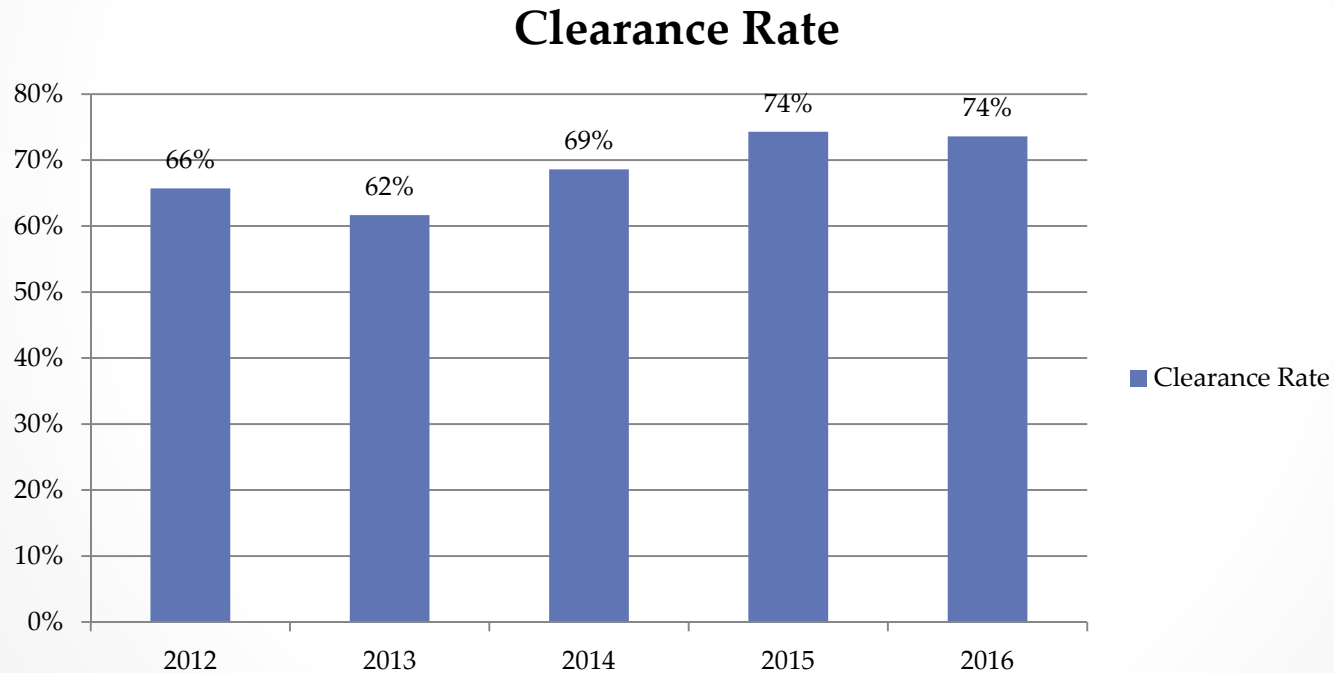

 - As of end of 09/30/2016



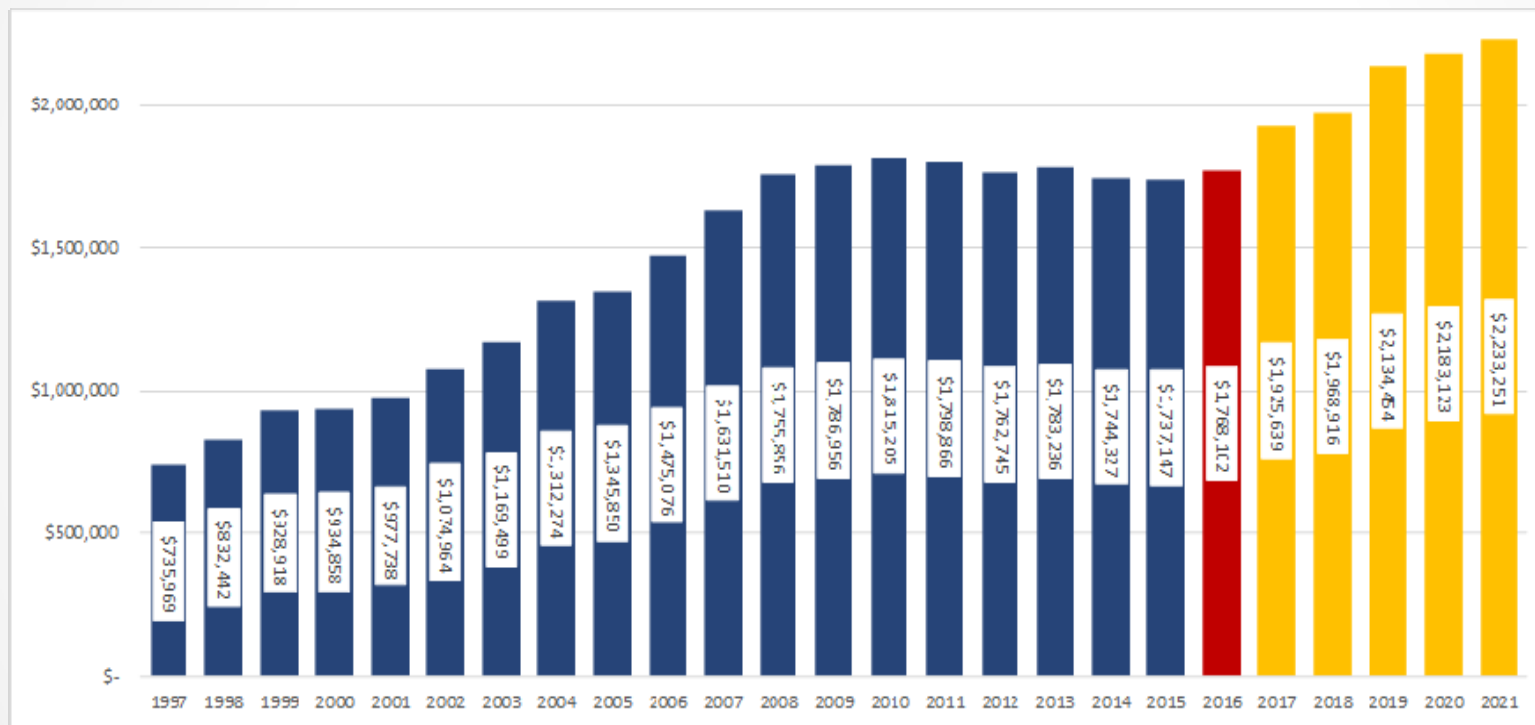

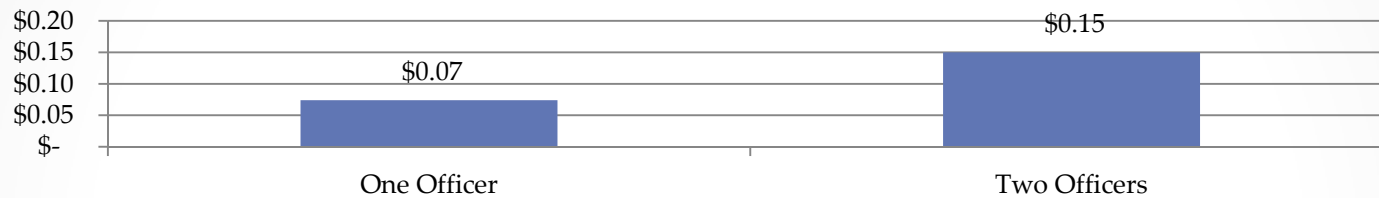

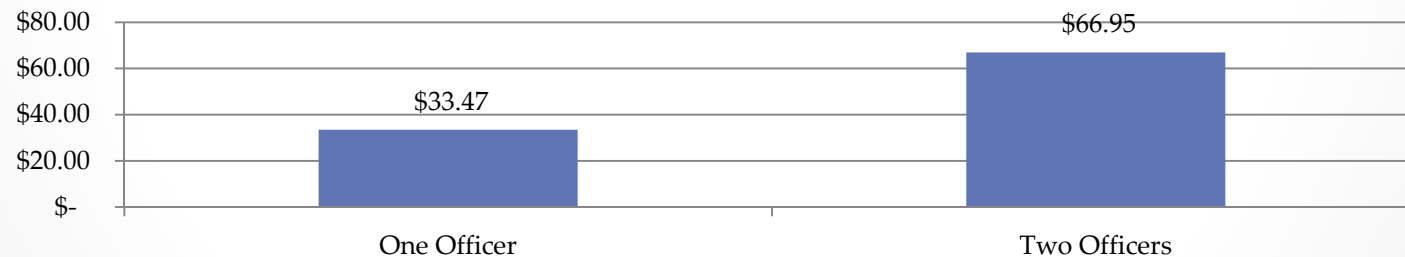

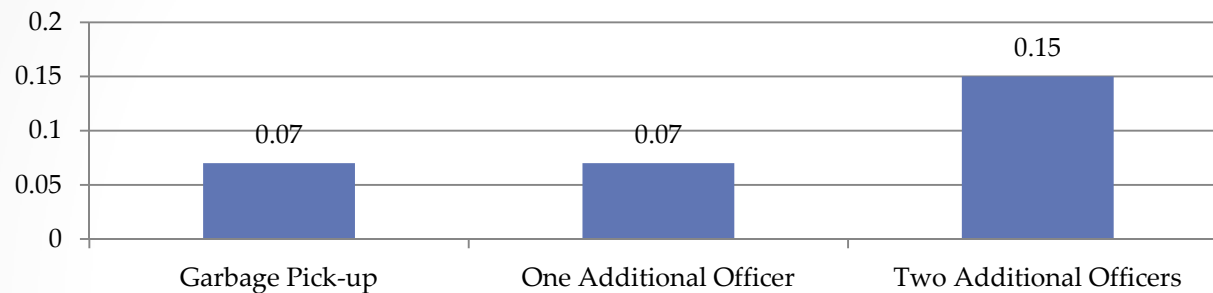

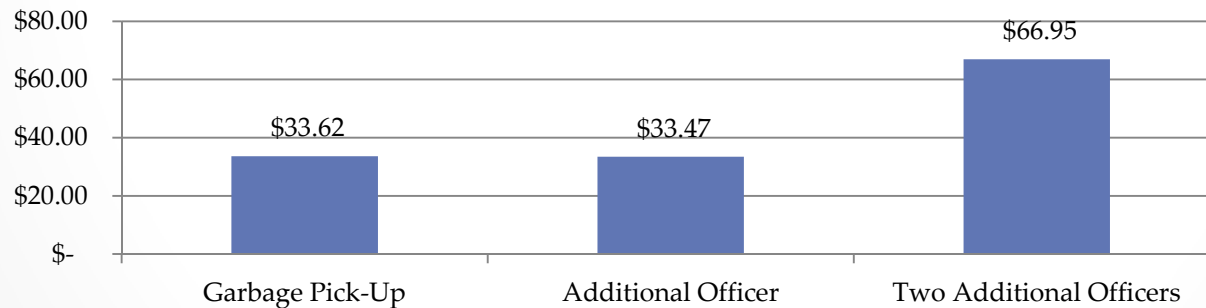

- TUT = Total Unobligated Time: minutes/hour
- Current Patrol only staffing =
 - 11 Total Patrol Officers
 - Staffing, at least 1 Officer per shift (try to maintain 2/shift)

City of Delafield Police Staffing

- UW Oshkosh study
 - 7 FTE disparity between DCP and comparable communities:
 - 4.6 FTE Sworn
 - 2.3 FTE Civilian (pg. 17)
 - Impressive Efficiency
 - Community Oriented strategies
 - Community interaction/outreach
 - Lake Patrol (pg. 18)
 - UCR Clearances
 - 2014 = 68%
 - 2015 = 74%
 - ICMA Avg. = 48.7% (pg. 18)
 - 2/3 increase would make staffing consistent with comparable communities
 - 7.3 FTE Patrol
 - 9.3 all Sworn positions (including Chief, Captain and Lieutenant)
 - Requesting additional funding to fill 2 FTE positions, 27% of Patrol recommendation (pg. 18)
 - Low Funding allocations
 - Recommendation: Alternative B = Increase Staffing to full needs, no decrease in services (pg. 19)

City of Delafield Police Staffing

- Recent additional services provided (Community Oriented Policing Strategies):
 - Vacation house checks
 - If notified, Officers physically check residences randomly while homeowners out of town
 - Business Walk-Through
 - Random foot patrol at retailers and other businesses to deter criminal activity
 - School Walk-Through/Other
 - Provide presence at local schools to enhance safety at those locations and develop relationships with staff and students
 - Presentations to staff on safety, i.e.: A.L.I.C.E.
 - Presentations to students and parents, i.e.: Internet Safety
 - Bank Walk-Through
 - Providing a presence to deter criminal activity
 - Community Events
 - Community Fest
 - National Night Out
 - Internships
 - Average 2/year, either through WCTC or a 4 year College (UW-W/Carroll)
 - Prescription drug drop box
 - Meetings with Chamber of Commerce and other community organizations
 - Anonymous Controlled Substance Disposal
 - Training Hosted
 - As often as practicable from outside vendors to any agency interested in sending a member, for reduced rates for our members to attend
 - Boat Patrol
 - Primary boating season in 2016 (Memorial Day – Labor Day)
 - 2016 - 348.5 hrs on lake (not including boat maintenance, records and/or travel to/from boathouse)
 - 2015 – 246 hrs on lake (wet August)

City of Delafield Police Staffing

- Benefits
 - Additional coverage
 - More Officers able to respond to calls decreases the response time for calls for service
 - Ability to increase directed patrol to address citizen complaints (Traffic)
 - More of the above/more frequent rate
 - Able to increase frequency and rate of house checks, business/school/bank foot patrols
 - Officer Safety
 - More consistent, reliable response by back up Officers trained and held accountable by Delafield department policies/procedures
 - Detective Position
 - Potential to create a Detective position in near future to increase the efficiency in complicated investigations and help dealing with case management and UCR/IBR reporting procedures
